Keynote Speaker

Dr. Kalee De France will deliver the keynote address, titled "Life trajectories: understanding the effects of poverty on development".

Abstract: The effects of poverty are consistent: growing up in poverty leads to worse outcomes on many indices of well-being. However, we often look at single snapshots of development, failing to capture the ways that poverty can get under the skin and disrupt trajectories of human development. My talk will provide a brief overview of this trajectory approach to the effects of poverty. We will follow up with an introduction to my research on the role of emotions and emotion regulation in making sense of the effects of poverty, and some of the more promising prevention and intervention work in the field.
